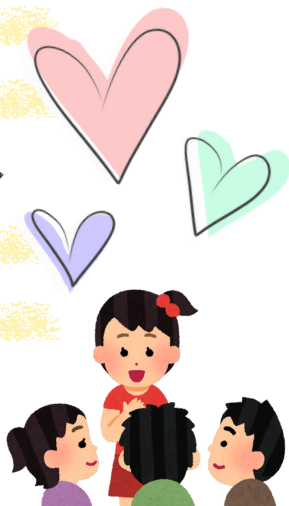

## KINDNESS

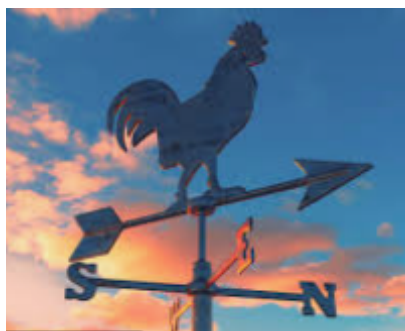

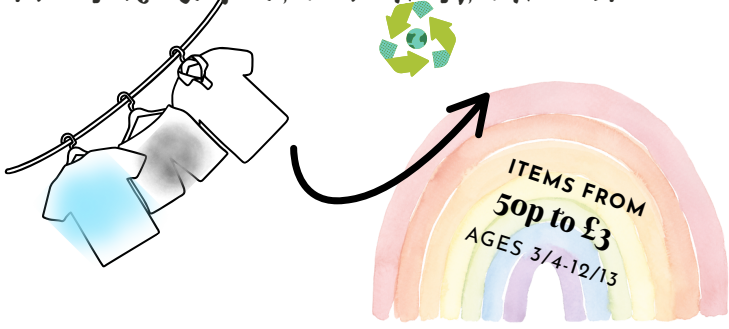
