Finally, Happy Christmas to you all. We wish our whole school family a blessed, joyful and peaceful Christmas holiday.

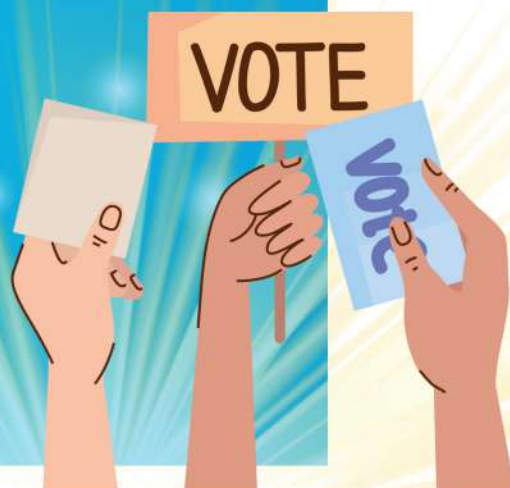

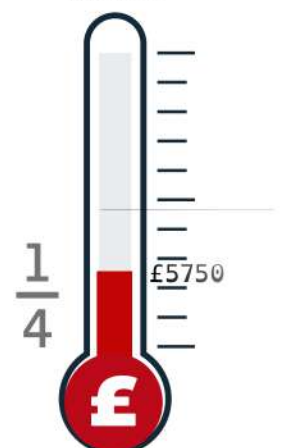
