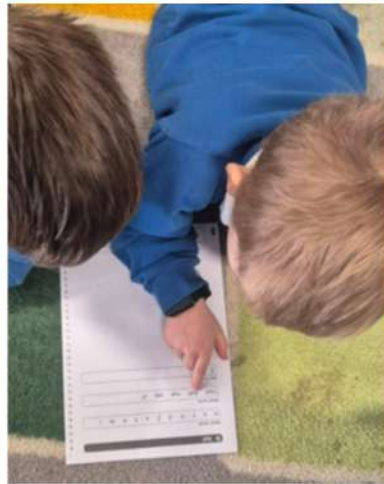
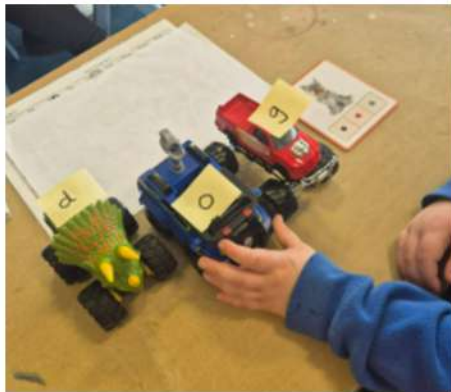
## Class 3
