## THREE COUNTIES SHOW

**Best Thing We Did This Week – A Fantastic Day at the Three Counties Show!**

On Friday, the whole school enjoyed an exciting and memorable visit to the Three Counties Show, packed with hands-on activities, learning opportunities and plenty of fun. The beautiful sunshine made it a perfect day to explore everything the show had to offer.

**Class 1** had a wonderful day meeting the hounds, decorating plant pots ready to grow sunflowers at home, and learning all about bees and honey. They also met cows, sheep and pygmy goats, bravely stroked tarantulas, tried milking a cow and even dug for potatoes. Through these activities, the children learned more about farming, food production, wildlife and where many everyday products come from.

**Class 2** enjoyed relaxing in the Alpaca Café before taking part in a variety of sporting activities, including lacrosse and softball. They also had great fun in the popular Build a Pony area, developing teamwork, coordination and confidence while learning more about caring for animals.

**Class 3** took part in a hobby horse workshop and visited Adam Henson's World of Pigs. They challenged themselves on the climbing wall, watched a search and rescue demonstration in Adventure Avenue, explored the "Nature in Your School" exhibit and finished the day at the Young Farmers Arena for the exciting Farmers' Egg Drop competition. Throughout the day, they learned about countryside careers, environmental conservation and the importance of resilience and problem-solving.

**Class 4** spent time in Adventure Avenue watching a military display, where they received complimentary Army necklaces. They then visited the climbing wall to learn about search and rescue operations, took part in pastry making with the Ladies in Pigs, attended a NatWest Money Workshop and discovered a fascinating range of creatures in the Bug Tent, from orb-weaver spiders to enormous stick insects. Their activities encouraged learning about financial responsibility, food production, teamwork and the natural world.

As well as visiting their class activities, pupils enjoyed many spectacular attractions around the showground. We watched incredible displays of horsemanship, including riders standing on horses and performers running alongside them. We saw sheep shearing demonstrations and admired stunning floral displays and horticultural exhibits. One of the highlights was a delightful Shetland pony show, where a talented dog amazed the audience by jumping onto the pony's back!

The day provided a wonderful opportunity for children to learn about agriculture, animal welfare, conservation, rural industries and the skills needed in a variety of careers. Most importantly, it created lasting memories and gave pupils experiences that simply cannot be replicated in the classroom.

A huge thank you goes to Mrs Morgan for organising such a fantastic trip. We are also very grateful to all the parents and carers who helped by dropping off and collecting the children, ensuring the day ran smoothly.

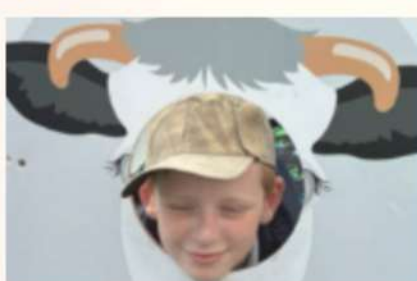

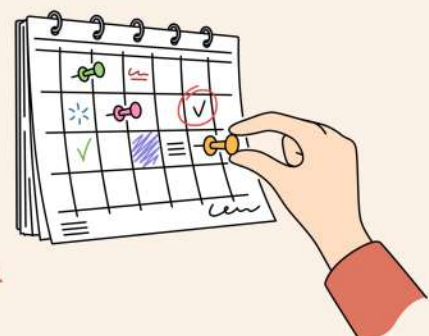
