Class 1 & 2

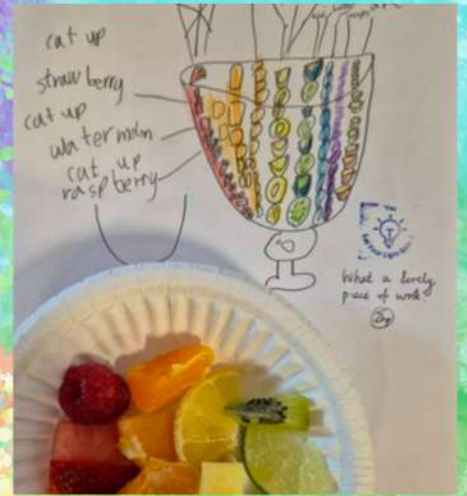
Class 1 and 2 made fruit salads from their designs and enjoyed the sunshine whilst having a picnic on the field.

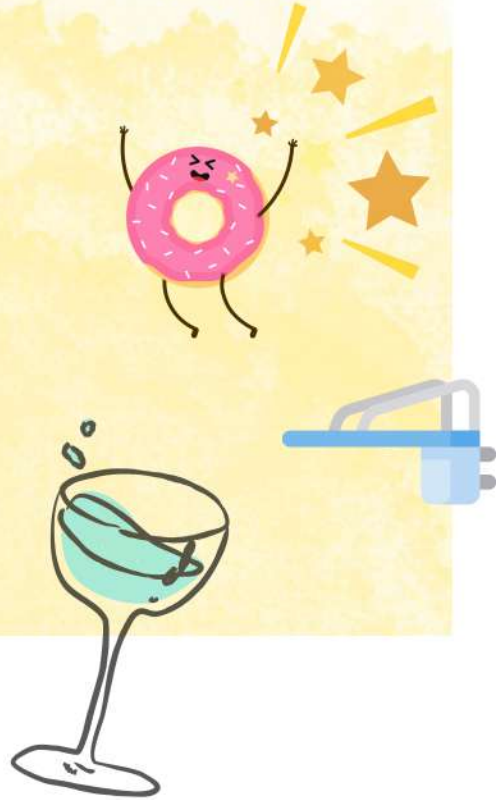
