Claire's training aims to equip us with the necessary tools and a consistent language to turn this vision into reality. I am certain we will have a great day together, and I hope you enjoy the INSET.

Additionally, this week, I have been working to onboard our whole school with a programme called MyHappyMind. Our motivation is always to nurture the potential for the brightest future for all our children. One of our commitments is to ensure children are ready to leave school with a deep sense of their personal values and resilience to face challenges in life. After the Easter holidays, every child will receive a weekly lesson as part of our core curriculum offer. MyHappyMind is an NHS-backed programme in primary schools, secondary schools, and nurseries, focused on building resilience, self-esteem, and happiness in children. It employs preventative strategies firmly rooted in science, research, and the fields of neuroscience and positive psychology.
