THIS WEEK



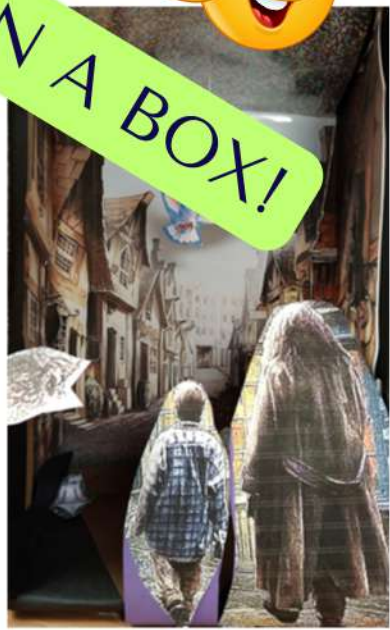
