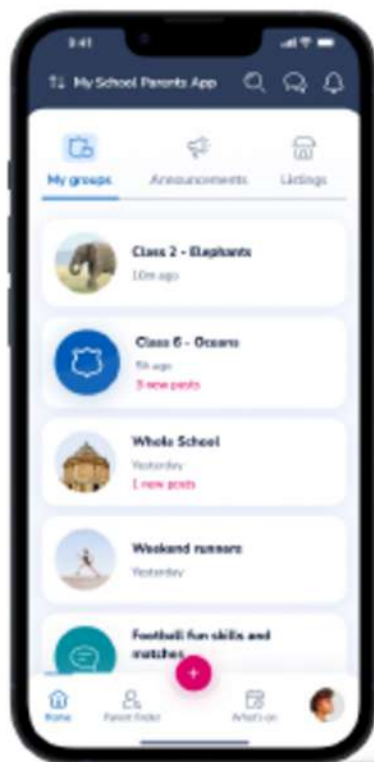

AMENDMENTS TO CONSTITUTION

At the AGM meeting we agreed to continue with the constitution provided by Parentkind, which had been used previously. However, the following amendments were suggested:

- Travel & Accommodation expenses can not be claimed by PTA members.
- PTA members will not be investing funds or offering loans.
- If an event is asking for parent donations, PTA members can not claim back their expenses for their donations.

Election of PTA positions also took place. People were either nominated or self-nominated, then a majority vote decided the outcome:
