# MUSIC LESSONS

## Instrumental and Vocal tuition in school - 2024-25



Severn Arts provides music tuition in your school. If your child is interested in learning to play an instrument or would like to have singing lessons during the school day this can now be booked directly with Severn Arts.

Instruments\* in the brass, stringed and woodwind families are all taught as well as percussion, piano and guitar, and many of the instruments taught are available to hire. Vocal tuition is also offered.

Lessons are available as 20-minute individual lessons (£15.76 per lesson), 30-minute individual lessons (£23.64 per lesson) or small group lessons for 2/3 pupils (£7.88 per lesson).

Severn Arts teachers are enhanced DBS checked and safeguarding trained.

Please note, if your child is already receiving lessons, please log into your account to re-register for the new academic year as lessons will not roll over.

To book lessons at your school, please follow this link, [School Music Tuition](#) or scan the QR code below. Once you have ordered tuition, Severn Arts will confirm availability and issue an invoice a few weeks before the start of each term. Payment must then be made before lessons can commence. Severn Arts will agree lesson details with your school.

Severn Arts also has a large stock of good quality instruments available to hire (free for those who meet specific [criteria](#)). Instrument hire can be ordered through our website or by going to [Instrument Hire](#). Please note, we do not hire guitars or keyboards.
