Good morning to you all and I hope this newsletter finds you well. It has certainly been a scorching week in school.

It has been fantastic to welcome Mrs Hernandez-Cox back. I know the children and staff have missed her and it is great to have her back in our community.

We have been thrilled to have had the opportunity to show numerous interested families around our school this week and host a number of taster days. When I began my role as Head Teacher, we had 73 pupils on role, however the school has a capacity for 105. Every child brings an Age Weighted Pupil Unit (AWPU), which is the amount of money that every maintained school receives for each pupil that is on the school roll. Therefore, it is essential that the school is at full capacity for financial reasons as when we are not at capacity, our budget reflects this.

I'm pleased to say that we have made great leaps in filling the school and currently have 99 pupils on roll! We are full in certain year groups which is hugely positive and helps our curriculum to be cumulative for the children. However, **we need your help to recruit children in next years reception and current Year 4 .**

I am writing this awaiting a fabulous time together at sports day and the Summer Fayre. My sincere thanks to Katie Clark, Dani Clark, Sarah Loader, Jeni and Adam Frost for their tremendous efforts in organising this event. We are so lucky to have them!

I have been monitoring school attendance closely this year and our percentages continue to fall which is a concern for us all.

It is a key priority to work together to improve school attendance and we recognise that the barriers to accessing education are wide and complex.

Good attendance is essential for pupils to get the most out of their school experience, including their attainment, wellbeing, and wider life chances. It is well evidenced that pupils with the highest attainment at the end of Key Stage 2 have higher rates of attendance over the key stage compared to those with the lowest attainment. Whilst we believe in the development of the whole child, we recognise strong attainment does have huge impact on their brightest future and attendance is a key factor in this.

If your child's attendance is less than 90%, this is classed as **PERSISTENT** absence and at this point our attendance team will be making contact with you (from September 24) to see how we can work together to improve attendance. Mrs. Jackson, Mrs. Myers and myself will be in this team.
