- Improve **attendance** rates across the school to the target of 96%

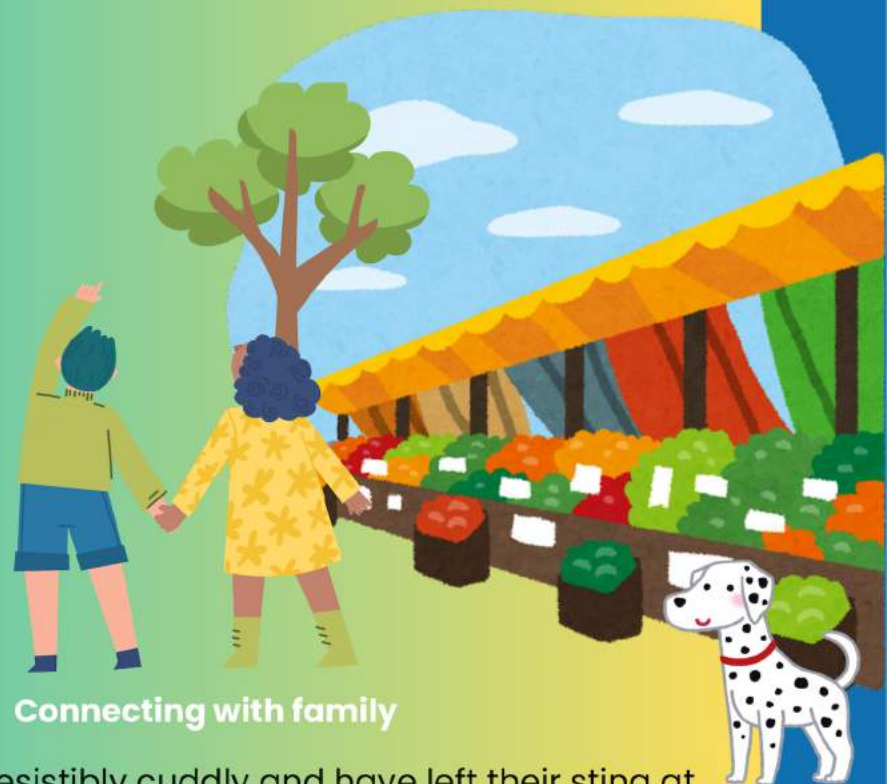
