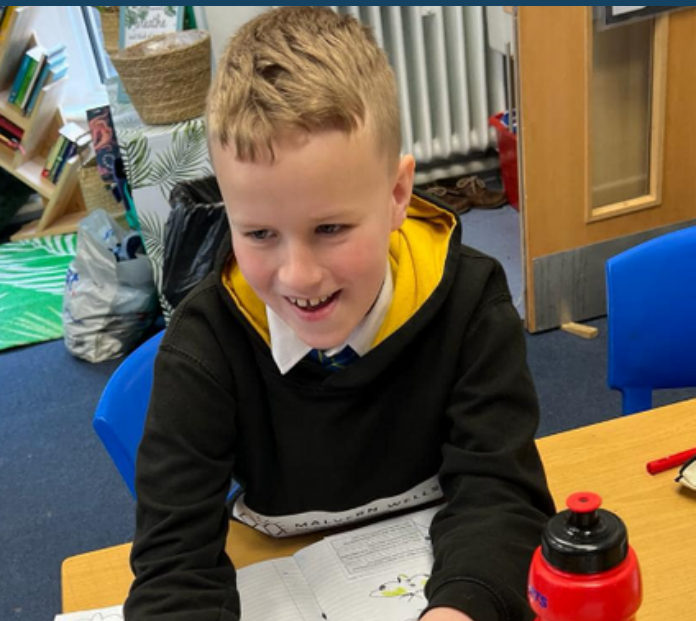


A NOTE FROM THE HEAD TEACHER
