do some species go extinct and what can we do to save endangered species? Join Prof Ben Garrod as he explores how extinction is one of the most


evolving topics - what happened successful animals of all time went extinct, and how the mighty Tyrannosaurus rex was killed.


Come and listen to young people from the Malvern area take part in an exciting crash debating session. (11-16 years)
