This week, we explored how the ancient Egyptians used mummification — and we tried it ourselves by mummifying tomatoes!

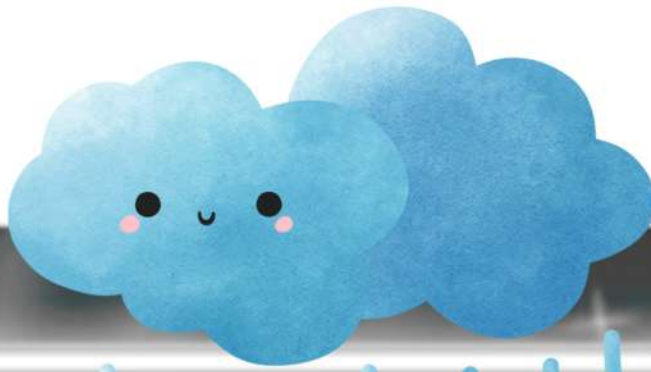
Class 4 – Year 5 & Year 6
